Following the death of Her Late Majesty Queen Elizabeth II. peacefully at Balmoral yesterday evening, we enter a period of mourning for ten days.

Holy Trinity Church will be open Monday – Saturday from 2.00pm – 6.00pm for private prayer, to pay respects, and there is a Book of Condolence for all who wish to, to sign.

Flowers may be laid at the Parish Beacon on Thorney Green (no cellophane wrapping please).

PROCLAMATION DAY SATURDAY 10TH SEPTEMBER

Proclamation Day will be Saturday 10th September. Flags will fly at full mast from 11.00 a.m. to sunset on that day. His Majesty's Accession will be Proclaimed at Ipswich County Hall by the High Sheriff, and at 3.00 p.m. the Proclamation will be read by the Mayors of all Suffolk's principal market towns. There will be a short Service of Affirmation for the Accession of the new King, following the reading of the Proclamation, at the Cathedral in Bury St Edmunds, and in principal churches throughout Suffolk.

Flags will be flown at half-mast again from the evening. There will be a Vigil Service for the late Queen at St Paul's Cathedral in the evening.
